
A psychic predicted an imminent war between Russia and China



Her name carries the scent of a bygone America, one filled with popular mysticism and political turmoil. **Jeane Dixon**, one of the most famous psychics of the 20th century, is back in the spotlight nearly three decades after her death in 1997. Thanks to predictions unearthed from her 1969 book My Life And Prophecies, many are now wondering if this mysterious figure saw the future more clearly than once thought.

Dixon became an American cultural icon in the 1960s after claiming to have predicted the assassination of President John F. Kennedy and the premature departure of Richard Nixon from office. Her weekly astrology column, syndicated in hundreds of newspapers, made her a household name, and her influence often rivaled that of political pundits and serious commentators.

In 2025, it's another of her prophecies that's capturing attention. In My Life And Prophecies, Dixon wrote that between 2025 and 2037, a war would erupt between China and Russia. She predicted that "in 2025, Red China will have

reached an economic and political stability sufficient to forge ahead and become the Great Conqueror," while "Russia will also have expanded her direct sphere of influence. It will no longer be limited to the countries of Eastern Europe, but will now include Libya, Ethiopia, Iran, and much of Africa."

At a time when geopolitical tensions between Beijing and Moscow are visibly growing, even skeptics are revisiting Dixon's writings with new curiosity. Of course, her track record was far from flawless: she famously predicted the birth of a "Messiah child" in 1962 who would change the world by the year 2000—a prophecy that clearly did not materialize.
