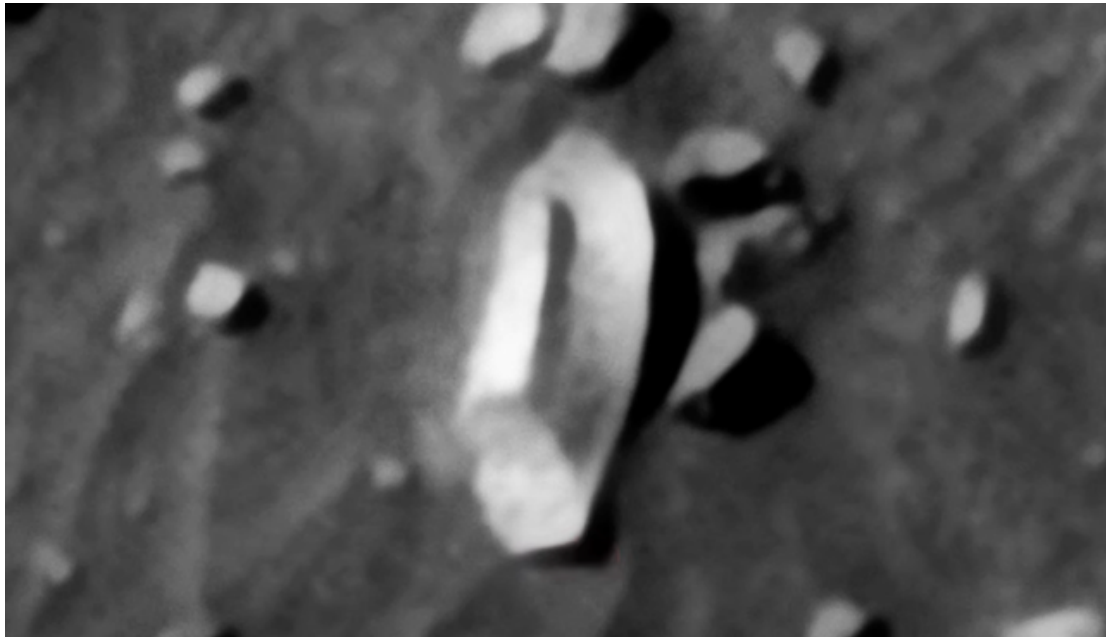


300-Meter Spaceship Spotted on Mars
