

The Village in Japan Where they Believe Jesus Died

In the quiet village of **Shingo** in northern Japan, there exists a surprising local legend that claims Jesus Christ did not die on the cross in Jerusalem, but instead lived out his final years there. According to this tale, Jesus escaped crucifixion, fled to Japan, and settled in Shingo, where he became a rice farmer, married, and had children.
